

Bell Buckle Board of Mayor and Aldermen
Meeting Minutes
July 14, 2015

Bell Buckle Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Tuesday, July 14, 2015 at 6 PM. Members present were Mayor Webb, and Aldermen Winnett, Chilton, and Hunt. Alderman Reagor was absent.

Mayor Webb called the meeting to order. Alderman Hunt, seconded by Alderman Winnett, made a motion to suspend the reading of the minutes from June 9 and the special called meeting on June 25. All aye. Alderman Chilton, seconded by Alderman Hunt, made a motion to approve the minutes from June 9 and the special called meeting on June 25. Motion carried. Alderman Winnett, seconded by Alderman Hunt, made a motion to accept the financial reports. All aye.

Water Supervisor Jason Lewis gave the Water Report. Both bacteriological samples were negative for coliform. They have run into some snags in the Hinkle Hill project but are moving forward. Water loss was 6%. Mayor Webb asked if the flushing percentage could be shown separately on upcoming reports.

There was no Sewer Report.

Alderman Hunt reported for the Water/Sewer Board. The computer that shows the telemetry went down the first of the month. Jason and Ronnie have been making rounds to keep watch on the tanks. We are working with David Hannon on getting that fixed.

Alderman Hunt presented the TML Risk Management Safety Grant Resolution which is a 50/50 grant. The town would spend \$1000 on safety equipment and be reimbursed \$500. The equipment purchased could be safety related to fire, police or water/sewer. Mayor Webb, seconded by Alderman Hunt, made a motion to approve. Motion carried.

Fire Chief Ronnie Lokey gave the Fire Department Report. There were a total of 12 calls for the month. Eight were fire related which included 1 motor vehicle accident, 2 structure fires mutual aid, 1 good intent call, 3 false alarms from Webb School, & 1 public service call. Four were medical calls. The department held 2 training sessions, tested the hose on 2 trucks, and did hose-load training. The department made \$1300 parking cars during the RC Moon Pie Event. The grant applications to Firehouse Subs and the TN Department of Forestry were both turned down for this year.

Chief Wiley gave the Police Department Report. There were 19 citations, 24 warnings, 8 county assists and 2 reports. Things went smoothly with safety at the RC Moon Pie Event. Mayor Webb expressed sympathy to Chief Wiley about the death of his brother.

Mayor Webb reported for the Planning Commission. The commission reviewed a Site Plan for the tentative buyer of the Rowlette Bed & Breakfast. The Special Exception for the B & B follows the property but they want to remodel a small building on the property into a caretaker's home. This met the zoning requirements and was approved by commission. Separate water & sewer taps will be purchased for the home. Article V was reviewed in detail with several changes made to what is allowed in the commercial 1 and commercial 2 zoning. This will be updated and passed to the Board of Mayor & Aldermen when approved by the Planning Commission.

Alderman Hunt gave the Chamber of Commerce Report. The RC Moon Pie Festival went smoothly. The meeting with EMA has been postponed until later this month.

The Park & Recreation Report was given by Alderman Hunt. Vandalism occurred at the park this week with grills and tables being overturned and damaged. Chief Wiley and Officer Wiley are working to find the ones responsible. The installation of cameras is being discussed.

Mayor Webb reported that the Historical Commission met and they are putting together some information. Billy Phillips resigned and has been replaced by Greg Heinike. The Mayor stated that he feels the commission will help the merchants and be Commercial-1 driven.

There were no reports from the Arts Commission nor the Safety Council.

Mayoral Updates: Mayor Webb stated he was sent a revised agreement for the Joint Economic & Community Development Board. There were a couple of questions regarding the agreement and this will be reviewed next month.

There was no Old or New Business.

There being no further business, Alderman Chilton made a motion to adjourn.
