

Bell Buckle Board of Mayor and Aldermen  
Special Called Meeting Minutes  
May 21, 2018

Bell Buckle Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in special session on Monday, May 21<sup>st</sup> at 5 PM. Members present were Mayor Jenny Hunt, Vice Mayor Reagor, and Aldermen Wheeler. Aldermen Rooney and Williams were absent. There had been a public hearing prior to the meeting.

Mayor Hunt called the meeting to order and noted items to be discussed for the special called meeting.

An Ordinance regarding a Business Privilege Tax was presented for 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading. This will become effective on July 1, 2018. VM Reagor, seconded by Alderman Wheeler, made a motion to approve. Motion carried.

Amendments to the Water Rules & Regulations and Fee Schedule were presented. This is regarding Rental Property Ordinance 14-001, Chapter 18-117, adding the stipulation that renters must show lease agreement to obtain water in their name. The Fee Schedule change updated the water tap charges by adding several tap sizes. (see attached) VM Reagor, seconded by Alderman Wheeler, made a motion to approve both amendments. All aye.

A Resolution for a lease/purchase agreement on a new Police Vehicle was presented. The planned increase in property tax will be designated for this expenditure. VM Reagor, seconded by Alderman Wheeler, made a motion to approve this Resolution. Motion carried.

The Amended Budget for 2017-18 was presented for 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading. VM Reagor, seconded by Alderman Wheeler, made a motion to approve. All aye.

The Anticipated Budget for 2018-19 was presented for 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading. VM Reagor, seconded by Alderman Wheeler, made a motion to approve. Motion carried.


The 2018-19 Property Tax Rate was presented for 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading at 56 cents per \$100 of assessed value on all real and personal property. This is a 10 cent increase and as stated above, the increase is designated towards the lease/purchase of the new police vehicle. VM Reagor, seconded by Alderman Wheeler, made a motion to approve. All aye.

The Budget Ordinance 2018-19 was presented for 1<sup>st</sup> Reading. There will be a Public Hearing and 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading on June 12. VM Reagor, seconded by Alderman Wheeler, made a motion to approve. Motion carried.

There being no further business, VM Reagor, seconded by Alderman Wheeler, made a motion to adjourn. All aye.
